WHAT IS A SUPER PAC?

A Super PAC is a type of independent political action committee which may raise unlimited sums of money from corporations, unions, and individuals but is not permitted to contribute to or coordinate directly with parties or candidates.

HOW DOES A SUPER PAC DIFFER FROM A PAC?

Traditional political action committees are limited in who can give to them and limited in the amounts they can give to candidates. Super PACs can accept unlimited funds from appropriate sources and make unlimited expenditures to influence the outcome of congressional races provided they are made properly.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF A SUPER PAC?

The creation of the Better Access to Chiropractic (BAC-PAC) will allow the chiropractic profession to increase its political influence with key decision makers in Congress by getting involved in a number of targeted congressional campaigns.
